In-Person Service Information Sheet

Thank you for your interest in our In-Person Service! In order to keep everyone safe here is some information on how the service will work:

- ***Reservations will be required to attend the In-Person Service and can be made by calling the office at 480-488-3283 or by email at goodshepherdaz@msn.com. Reservations will be first come first served.***
- Upon arriving for the service, you will enter the church through the main double doors. Although our Ushers will be working swiftly to get you in and seated, if a line forms please maintain social distancing of 6 feet and keep your mask on while waiting.
- The bathrooms in the church and through the main entrance of the Maitland Hall Building will be open before and after the service with a max of 1 person at a time. Please note, once you are seated you will not be able to leave your seat until the service ends.
- Once inside the church please follow the floor markings for the traffic flow and the pew markings for available seats. (See Attached Diagram) Please note, seating will start with the farthest pews from the entrance, i.e. the first in line will be in the second row on the left side, the second in line will be the first row on the right side, etc.
- We will have Holy Communion with Bread Only. An individual prefilled cup with a wafer will be available by the entrance doors.
- A printed service bulletin will be available at the entrance doors if you would like to follow along with the service. Please note, there are no Bibles, Book of Common Prayer or Hymn books available for use in the church pews at this time.
- Baskets will be located at the entrances to drop off your offerings while entering or leaving the service. The ushers will not be collecting offerings *during* the service.
- There will be one soloist. Unfortunately singing aloud during the service by anyone other than the soloist is not permitted at this time.
- At the end of the Service please wait in your seat until you are notified of your rows turn to exit. Once notified you will then exit following the same path as when you entered the church. Please note, exiting the church will start with the closest pews to the entrances, i.e. the last pew on the left side will exit first, the last pew on the right side will exit next, etc.

Here's what we need from you:

- Please bring a mask, which covers your nose and mouth, to wear during the entire service.
- Please read through the Covenant of Care from the Episcopal Diocese of Arizona Prior to attending the service. (located at all the entrances)
- Please rsvp/register in advance and do not bring more people than what you registered. We are limited to the number of participants and we do not want to turn anyone away!
- Lastly, be patient. Unfortunately rejoining in-person service is going to be different than it was before, but please know all the guidelines are in place to keep everyone safe!
